Time Travelling has built a trusted reputation and relationship with schools in the Diocese, to evolve into an event that schools know and respect. Our policy is to offer schools a taster of what Christianity and church is, we offer hospitality and a chance for them to experience the awe and wonder of a place of Christian worship and to meet those who are part of that community.

We aim to support the teaching of RE by providing an excellent learning experience for the children.

For those parishes wanting to run a TT event we would ask you to consider the following:

- Events should not to take place during Minster TT events as this has an impact on volunteers involved in both events.
- Worship may contain elements of: TT songs, candle to take away, optional prayer for children to join if they wish to.
- A TT manager *must* be part of your planning group and attend some planning meetings, supporting the planning and resourcing of activities. (If we are not involved then please *do not* call your event Time Travelling.)
- Funding: parishes should agree to fund the resources for the day and pay TT staff's travel expenses.
- Time Travelling is self funded and we would ask you for a donation to this valuable mission work.

We can advise and support with planning of themed days: Christmas, Easter, Harvest, patronal festivals, special events such as centenaries or 'Back to Church Sunday'.
